The Son of God Has Set Us Free from Sin and Death by His Grace

"Wisdom is justified by her deeds" (Matt. 11:19), and the true Wisdom of God, Christ Jesus, the incarnate Son, has justified us by His deeds. He prepares His way by the preaching of repentance, but He has suffered the violence of the Law and voluntarily handed Himself over to violent men, that we might eat and drink with Him in His Kingdom and "remain in the house forever" (John 8:35). He is "a friend of tax collectors and sinners" (Matt. 11:18–19), and He has rescued us by His grace from the slavery of sin and death. By the proclamation of His eternal Gospel "to those who dwell on earth, to every nation and tribe and language and people" (Rev. 14:6), "the righteousness of God has been manifested apart from the law" (Rom. 3:21), "that he might be just and the justifier of the one who has faith in Jesus" (Rom. 3:26). And by the hearing of that Gospel of Christ Jesus, "whom God put forward as a propitiation by his blood, to be received by faith" (Rom. 3:25), "you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free" (John 8:31–32).

OPENING PRAYER and CALLING ON GOD'S NAME (Pastor)

P - In the name of the Father, and the Son, and the Holy Spirit. Amen.

CONFESSION AND ABSOLUTION

P – Dear brothers and sisters in the Lord. In Paul's letter to the Ephesians (2.3) it is written: "we all once lived in the passions of our flesh, carrying out the desires of the body and the mind, and were by nature children of wrath, like the rest of mankind." In other words, we were all cut off from God and were sinners. By the **grace** God sent us the Savior and gave us knowledge of him through the **Scriptures** and through faith we become children of God. Sin, however, remains part of our daily routine. And this will be so until our death. We should be condemned for that. But the Father loves us and wants to forgive everyone who recognizes his unworthiness and seeks his grace. Let's pray:

READING OF REVELATION 14:6-7 (Penny)

⁶Then I saw another angel flying directly overhead, with an eternal gospel to proclaim to those who dwell on earth, to every nation and tribe and language and people. ⁷And he said with a loud voice, "Fear God and give him glory, because the hour of his judgment has come, and worship him who made heaven and earth, the sea and the springs of water."

READING OF EPISTLE - ROMANS 3:19-28 (Penny)

¹⁹Now we know that whatever the law says it speaks to those who are under the law, so that every mouth may be stopped, and the whole world may be held accountable to God. ²⁰For by works of the law no human being will be justified in his sight, since through the law comes knowledge of sin.

The Righteousness of God Through Faith

 21 But now the righteousness of God has been manifested apart from the law, although the Law and the Prophets bear witness to it $-^{22}$ the righteousness of God through faith in Jesus Christ for all who believe. For there is no distinction: 23 for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, 24 and are justified by his grace as a gift, through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus, 25 whom God put forward as a propitiation by his blood, to be received by faith. This was to show God's righteousness, because in his divine forbearance he had passed over former sins. 26 It was to show his righteousness at the present time, so that he might be just and the justifier of the one who has faith in Jesus.

²⁷Then what becomes of our boasting? It is excluded. By what kind of law? By a law of works? No, but by the law of faith. ²⁸ For we hold that one is justified by faith apart from works of the law.

³¹So Jesus said to the Jews who had believed him, "If you abide in my word, you are truly my disciples, ³² and you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free." ³³They answered him, "We are offspring of Abraham and have never been enslaved to anyone. How is it that you say, 'You will become free'?"

³⁴ Jesus answered them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, everyone who practices sin is a slave to sin. ³⁵ The slave does not remain in the house forever; the son remains forever. ³⁶ So if the Son sets you free, you will be free indeed.

SERMON - BACK TO BASICS (Romans 3:22-23 and 28)

THE APOSTLES' CREED BASED ON BIBLE VERSES

- **P -** In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. (Genesis 1:1)
- C I believe in God, the Father Almighty, Creator of heaven and earth.
- **P -** For God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life. (John 3:16)
 - C I believe in Jesus Christ, His Only Son, our Lord.
- **P -** The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most high will overshadow you. So the Holy One to be born will be called the Son of God. (Luke 1:35)
 - C He was conceived by the power of the Holy Spirit and born of the Virgin Mary.
 - P Pilate handed Him over to them to be crucified. (John 19:16)
 - C He suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried.
- **P -** [Christ] was put to death in the body but made alive by the Spirit, through whom also He went and preached to the spirits in prison. (1 Peter 3:18,19)
 - C He descended into hell.
- **P -** Don't be alarmed, you are looking for Jesus the Nazarene, who was crucified. He has risen! He is not here. See the place where they laid Him. (Mark 16:6)
 - C On the third day He rose again.
- **P -** When He had led them out to the vicinity of Bethany, He lifted up His hands and blessed them. While He was blessing them, He left them and was taken up into heaven. (Luke 24:50,51)
 - C He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father.
 - P We must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ. (2 Corinthians 5:10)
 - C He will come again to judge the living and the dead.
 - **P -** Do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit? (1 Corinthians 6:20)

C - I believe in the Holy Spirit.

P - Just as each of us has one body with many members... so in Christ we who are many form one body. (Romans 12:4,5)

C - I believe in the holy Christian Church, the Communion of Saints.

P - In Him we have redemption, through His blood, the forgiveness of sins. (Ephesians 1:7)

C - I believe in the forgiveness of sins.

P - Jesus answered him: "I tell you the truth, today you will be with me in paradise." (Luke 23:43)

C - I believe in the resurrection of the body and the life everlasting. Amen.
